

## Spanish 1, 3-5 Honors Summer Work

Your summer work assignment will be to use Duolingo daily from 5 June until 5 August.

- Your progress will be compiled on a weekly basis so, if you miss a day, you can make it up **so long as** you do it within the same week. Points will not carry over from week to week. For instance, if you need to get 140 points per week and, instead get 100 points one week and 180 the next you should not expect to get full credit. Actual grading policies for how to handle such situations will be determined by your teacher.
- You must take the placement test in Duolingo, place at a reasonable location, and continue from there. You may skip ahead, but if you're found taking lessons well below your skill, going back to past lessons unnecessarily, or intentionally reducing your score on the placement test points may be deducted as appropriate.
- If you are unable to complete the required number of points for a given week due to extenuating circumstances you must request permission from both [WILLIAMSEJ@scsk12.org](mailto:WILLIAMSEJ@scsk12.org) and [shipleyh@scsk12.org](mailto:shipleyh@scsk12.org) please email both people so whichever person is tracking your score will know about the deviation.

### Those entering Spanish 1 Honors

- Must get 70 points per week (comes out to about 5 min. per day)
- Prior to 1 July, you must email in a one page, double spaced, typed report on why learning Spanish is important. Send it to both email addresses above.

### Those entering Spanish 2 Honors

- (there is a separate assignment, refer to that handout)

### Those entering Spanish 3 Honors

- Must get 70 points per week (comes out to about 5 min. per day)

### Those entering Spanish 4 Honors

- Must get 140 points per week (comes out to about 10 min. per day)

### Those entering Spanish 5 Honors

- Must get 140 points per week (comes out to about 10 min. per day)

Your Spanish class is going to use Duolingo at school. These are the instructions to join Summer Honors Work!

**If you are on a smartphone or tablet:**

1. Download the Duolingo app and open it up.
2. Press Get Started. Then select Spanish.
3. Set your Daily Goal and continue (you can change this later).
4. Create a Profile:

On Android, press the menu icon at the top right corner and press Create a Profile.

On iOS, press Profile in the top left corner and press Create a Profile.

5. Type in your Name, Email and Password, then press Create.
6. Go to your Profile and press Progress Sharing.
7. Type in the following exactly:

8. Press Save Changes.
